Passenger Numbers
  - So far in May, we have seen an average of 84,308 passengers through TSA screening each day, which is 73.4% compared to 2019.
  - April had an average of 85,140 passengers screened at TSA, which was 75.5% compared to 2019 an dup five percentage points from March.
  - We are hoping to break the 100,000 passengers screened through TSA for the first time since pre-pandemic this upcoming Memorial Day Weekend.Vaccinations/Testing
  - LAX continues to offer both COVID-19 vaccinations (including second booster) and testing options.
  - Vaccinations are offered every Wednesday at Tom Bradley International Terminal
  - Antigen testing is now only available at Tom Bradley International Terminal, while PCR testing is only available at the lab across from Terminal 6.**Construction Update**
  - The Automated People Mover train guideway structure is now complete after the last concrete was poured in April.
  - Train stations are now more than 30% complete.

- The fifth pedestrian bridge (which will connect Terminals 5 and 6 to the Center Central Terminal Area station) was placed in April. Only one bridge remains – at Tom Bradley International – and will be placed later this year.
